

# **Operational Policy 2018/02**

# **Subject: Customer Identification**

## **Background**

- To protect the integrity of the tax and licencing systems we need to properly identify customers before we issue them a Tax Identification Number (TIN) or a vehicle or driver licence.
- Without strict adherence to this policy we are at risk of registering false identities and/or one person/business with multiple TIN numbers or vehicle or driver licences
- Legislative references:
  Section 41(3) and (4) of Income Tax Act in respect of a TIN
- There has been no previous policy on this subject

#### **Policy**

Effective from 1 November 2018, to verify your identification to register a vehicle, acquire a vehicle licence, driver's licence or TIN you must attend the IRD office in person and provide:

- 1. The appropriate application form (e.g. Registration Form, Vehicle/Driver Licencing Application) properly completed
- 2. One original document from Category A (NB: if a person has more than one passport both must be produced in the same name)
- 3. One original document from Category B
- 4. A clear photocopy of each of your ID documents

#### **Category A documents**

- Full birth certificate
- Solomon Islands Passport
- Solomon Islands Voter Enrolment ID Card
- Overseas passport\*
- Emergency travel document or Certificate of Identity
- Overseas Drivers' Licence

<sup>\*</sup> If you are providing identification in another language it must be accompanied by an English translation

#### **Category B documents**

- Solomon Islands driver licence
- NPF Identification card
- Student photo identification card
- Valid photo identification card from an employer
- A letter confirming registration as a student in the Solomon Islands, on the school letterhead\*\*
- An "offer of employment" letter from your employer, on their company letterhead with start date of employment\*\*
- International Drivers' Permit
- Statutory Declaration of your identify from a church leader or medical professional

#### Identification for non-individuals

Where you are registering a business or company you will require the above Category A and B identification documents for ALL Directors/Shareholders/Partners *in addition to*:

- A Certificate of Incorporation OR
- A Business Name Certificate

#### Please note:

If you are unable to provide the documents required you will be unable to get a TIN number, register or licence a vehicle or get a drivers licence.

#### What the policy means for Inland Revenue

- We can be assured all registrations are accurate and customers are properly identified
- Our system is better protected against fraud
- We will reduce the number of duplicate registrations
- IRD fully complies with legislative requirements
- Government revenue is not negatively affected

## Business and system impacts of the policy

- A set of instructions related to this policy is required
- All IRD staff need to understand both the policy and the process
- Customer advertising will be required
- No system changes are required

## Who needs to understand and apply this policy?

All IRD staff need to understand the policy however application of the policy will generally be limited to Vehicle Licensing Officers and the Tax Education team.

## Who is going to manage/coordinate the policy?
