

What is a lockdown?



Lockdown is an emergency protocol that requires citizens and residents within the defined emergency zone to stay at home or within a specified zone except for essential and emergency purposes. It is a security measure employed during emergency and restricts movement of people from leaving or entering a premises or defined restricted zone. This measure will support the Ministry of Health in performing their functions in containing the spread of COVID-19. (SIG Lockdown Plan, 2020).

The lockdown is proposed for 6pm Wednesday 20th to 6am Friday 22nd May 2020.





What is a curfew?



Curfew is a law stating that people must stay within their home premises during the declared curfew time. This law is enforced through Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2020 and will be applied only in the declared emergency zone of Honiara as and when required. (SIG Lockdown Plan, 2020).

What happens if you break the Lockdown Order?



Any person breaking the Lockdown Order will be punished with maximum penalty of SBD\$10,000 or face imprisonment for 5 years, or both, under the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2020

The lockdown is proposed 6pm Wednesday 20th to 6am Friday 22nd May 2020.







The lockdown proposed for 6pm Wednesday 20th to 6am Friday 22nd May 2020.




