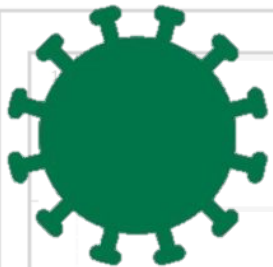

COVID-19 LOCKDOWN

What is a lockdown?

Lockdown is an emergency protocol that requires citizens and residents within the defined emergency zone to stay at home or within a specified zone except for essential and emergency purposes. It is a security measure employed during emergency and restricts movement of people from leaving or entering a premises or defined restricted zone. This measure will support the Ministry of Health in performing their functions in containing the spread of COVID-19. (SIG Lockdown Plan, 2020).

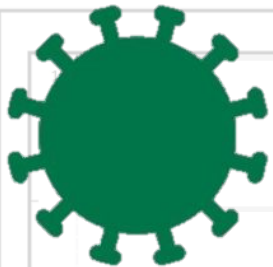

COVID-19 LOCKDOWN

What is a curfew?

Curfew is a law stating that people must stay within their home premises during the declared curfew time. This law is enforced through Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2020 and will be applied only in the declared emergency zone of Honiara as and when required. (SIG Lockdown Plan, 2020).

The lockdown is proposed for **6pm Wednesday 20th to 6am Friday 22nd May 2020.**

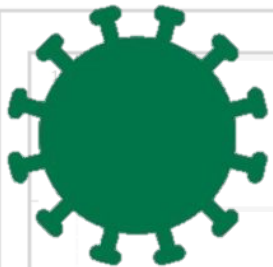

COVID-19 LOCKDOWN

What happens if you break the Lockdown Order?



Any person breaking the **Lockdown Order** will be punished with **maximum penalty of SBD\$10,000 or face imprisonment for 5 years, or both**, under the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2020

All emergencies must go through Police Check-points and will be under police escort to the nearest health facilities (Clinic or Hospital).

Ensure all medical documents are readily available for verification

The lockdown proposed for **6pm Wednesday 20th to 6am Friday 22nd May 2020.**



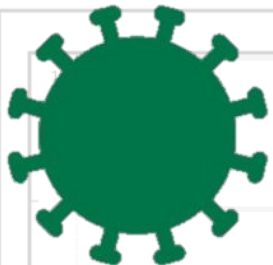
