EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2020

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(EXCEPTION FOR ENTRY INTO SOLOMON ISLANDS) (NO. 68) ORDER 2021

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 7(2) of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(No. 4) Regulations 2020* (Legal Notice No. 193 of 2020), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(Exception for Entry into Solomon islands)(No. 68) Order 2021.*

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the Gazette.

3 Non-citizens who may enter Solomon islands

Each of the persons specified in the Schedule, who are due to arrive in Solomon Islands on 18 February 2021 to participate in Operation Rai Balang 2021, may enter Solomon Islands despite the prohibition under regulation 7(1) of the Regulations.

4 Expiry

This Order expires on 18 May 2021.
