EMERGENCY POWERS ACT

(Cap. 11)

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(No. 4) REGULATIONS 2020

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(EXTENSION OF QUARANTINE)(NO. 13) ORDER 2021

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 29 of *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(No. 4) Regulations 2020* (Legal Notice No. 193 of 2020), being satisfied that it is necessary to do so to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 within Solomon Islands, make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Extension* of Quarantine)(No. 13) Order 2021.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the Gazette.

3 Extension of quarantine

- (1) The quarantine period of each person specified in Schedule 1 is extended from 21 February 2021 for a further period of 14 days ending on 7 March 2021.
- (2) The quarantine period of each person specified in Schedule 2 is extended from 21 February 2021 for a further period of 21 days ending on 14 March.
- (3) Each of those persons whose quarantine period is extended under subparagraph (1) or (2) must be quarantined at a quarantine station during the extended quarantine period.

4 Testing of persons whose quarantine extended under paragraph 3(1)

- (1) Each person whose quarantine period is extended under paragraph 3(1) must be tested two times for the presence of COVID-19 as follows:
 - (a) once during the period commencing on 26 February 2021 and ending on and including 3 March 2021; and
 - (b) once during the period commencing on 5 March 2021 and ending on and including 7 March 2021.

(2) Each of those persons must test negative for COVID-19 for each of those tests

5 Testing of persons whose quarantine extended under paragraph 3(2)

- (1) Each person whose quarantine period is extended under paragraph 3(2) must be tested three times for the presence of COVID-19 as follows:
 - (a) once during the period commencing on 26 February 2021 and ending on and including 3 March 2021; and
 - (b) once during the period commencing on 5 March 2021 and ending on and including 7 March 2021; and
 - (c) once during the period commencing on 12 March 2021 and ending on and including 14 March 2021.
- (2) Each of those persons must test negative for COVID-19 for each of those tests.
