**ELECTRICITY (CHARGES FOR SUPPLY)(NO. 3)  
REGULATIONS 2021**

I, Hon. Bradley Tovosia, Minister for Mines, Energy and Rural Electrification, and I, Hon. Harry Kuma, Minister for Finance and Treasury, under section 55(v) of the *Electricity Act* (Cap. 128) and with reference to section 26 of the *State Owned Enterprises Act 2007* (Act No. 7 of 2007), on the recommendation of the Authority, make the following Regulations:

**1 Citation**

These Regulations may be cited as the *Electricity (Charges for Supply)(No. 3) Regulations 2021*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on 1 August 2021.

**3 Definition**

In these Regulations:

“*non-regular customer*” means a customer who owns a generation facility

and is connected through a kilowatt metre.

#### 4 Charges for supply of electricity

The rates of charges for the supply of electricity from Authority public installations:

- (a) for prepaid customers are specified in Schedule 1; and
- (b) for postpaid customers are specified in Schedule 2; and
- (c) for non-regular customers are specified in Schedule 3.

#### 5 Repeal

The *Electricity (Charges for Supply)(No. 2) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 173 of 2021) are repealed.

**PRICE CONTROL (APPLICATION TO GOODS AND RESTRICTION OF PRICES) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 11) ORDER 2021**

I, Hon. Fredrick Kologeto, Minister for Commerce, Industries, Labour and Immigration, having consulted the Prices Advisory Committee, under sections 4 and 6 of the *Price Control Act* (Cap. 64), make the following Order:

1. This Order is the *Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) (Amendment)(No. 11) Order 2021*.
2. This Order commences on the date this Order is published in the *Gazette*.
3. The Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) Order 1987 (LN 47 of 1987) is amended in Schedule 3 by deleting the item for serial No. 13 (Petroleum Products) and substituting:
