(Cap. 64)

PRICE CONTROL (APPLICATION TO GOODS AND RESTRICTION OF PRICES) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 16) ORDER 2021

In exercise of powers conferred upon me by sections 4 and 6 of the *Price Control Act*, I make this Order-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the *Price Control (Application to Goods and Restrictions of Prices) Amendment) (No. 16) Order 2021* and shall be effective on the 1st of September 2021.
- 2. The Price Control (Application to Good and Restriction of Prices) Order 1987 (Legal Notice. 47 of 1987) is amended in Schedule 3 by revoking serial No. 13 (Petroleum Products) and substituting the following"

PRICE CONTROL (APPLICATION TO GOODS AND RESTRICTION OF PRICES) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 17) ORDER 2021

I, Hon. Fredrick Kologeto, Minister for Commerce, Industries, Labour and Immigration, having consulted the Prices and Advisory Committee, under sections 4 and 6 of the *Price Control Act* (Cap. 64), make the following Order:

- 1. This Order is the *Price Control (Application to Goods and Restrictions of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 17) Order 2021.*
- 2. This Order commences on 6 September 2021.
- 3. The Price Control (Application to Good and Restriction of Prices) Order 1987 (Cap. 64, LN 47 of 1987) is amended in Schedule 3 by deleting the item for serial No. 12 (Liquid Petroleum Gas) and substituting the following:

"12 LIQUID PETROLEUM GAS
