EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (DECLARATION OF TULAGI AS EMERGENCY ZONE) ORDER 2022

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 13 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Declaration of Tulagi as Emergency Zone) Order 2022.*

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the date it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Definition of "Tulagi"

In this Order:

"Tulagi" means the area in Solomon Islands that is:

- (a) bounded by a line with the coordinates specified in Part A of the Schedule; and
- (b) indicated by the red line on the map in Part B of the Schedule.

4 Tulagi declared as emergency zone

Tulagi is declared to be an emergency zone.
