EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) REGULATIONS 2022

**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(EXEMPTION FROM HOME
QUARANTINE PERIOD)(NO. 6) ORDER 2022**

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 10 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2022* (Legal Notice 112 of 2022), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(Exemption from Home Quarantine Period)(No. 6) Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Exemption from home quarantine period

- (1) Namson Tran is exempted from being home quarantined for the home quarantine period.
- (2) The exemption under subparagraph (1) is subject to the condition that, during the number of days immediately after this Order takes effect for which the person would but for this exemption be home quarantined, the person exempted:
 - (a) must be accommodated alone at his home in Honiara in a manner that complies with the Government's quarantine procedures; and
 - (b) may only leave his home to attend the National Parliament; and
 - (c) must be transported from his home to the National Parliament, and from the National Parliament to his home, in accordance with the Government's quarantine procedures; and
 - (d) when attending the National Parliament must:
 - (i) maintain physical isolation from any other person through social distancing; and
 - (ii) wear a face mask at all times; and

- (iii) regularly use hand sanitiser; and
- (e) must, each day the person attends the National Parliament, be tested for COVID-19 before entering the National Parliament by a RAT test, and must test negative for COVID-19 for the test.
