EMERGENCY POWERS ACT

(Cap. 11)

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021 EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(HONIARA EMERGENCY ZONE) (RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT OF SMALL CRAFTS AND OUTBOARD MOTOR VESSELS) ORDER 2022

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 17 of the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021(Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Small craft and Outboard Motors) Order 2022.*

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the Gazette.

3 Restriction of movement of small crafts and outboard motors

A small craft or an outboard motor may only, come alongside or berth or depart from Honiara at a designated area which is the Solomon Islands Ports Authority Yacht Boat Area.

4 Mandatory COVID-19 tests for arrivals and departures

- (1) A person upon arriving or departing must be tested for the presence of COVID-19 by health officials from the Ministry of Health and Medical Services.
- (2) If a person tests positive for COVID-19:
 - (a) he or she must immediately be quarantined at his or her place of residence and self-isolate; or
 - (b) not be allowed to travel and immediately proceed to take steps to be quarantined at his or her place of residence and self-isolate.
- (3) If a person develops COVID-19 symptoms on arrival he or she must proceed to self-isolation at his or her place of residence for a period of 10 days and inform the health officials from the Ministry of Health and Medical Services.

Requirements for persons within Honiara Emergency Zone

A person who arrives by a small craft or an outboard motor at the Solomon Islands Ports Authority Yacht boat area, must;

- (a) be vaccinated against COVID-19; and
- (b) have his or her vaccination certificate at all times; and
- (c) wear a face mask; and

- (d) practice social distancing; and
- (e) wash his or her hands frequently; and
- (f) use hand sanitizer frequently;
- (g) must practice COVID-19 safe measures within 10 days of his or her arrival.
