APPOINTMENT OF SOLOMON ISLANDS PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE UNITED NATIONS, AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND HIGH COMMISSIONER TO CANADA

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 127 of the Constitution, and in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister tendered after consultation with the Public Service Commission, I, SIR DAVID VUNAGI, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of Saint John, Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands do hereby appoint -

JANE MUGAFALU KABUI WAETARA

to be Solomon Islands Permanent Representative to the United Nations, and as Ambassador to the United States of America and High Commissioner to Canada for a period of three (3) years with effect from the date of this instrument.
