SECTION B - SCOPE OF DUTIES

The Ministry of Finance and Treasury is mandated to facilitate sound advice on Monetary, Budget and Fiscal Policy to the Solomon Islands Government. The core tasks of the Ministry include financial reporting, revenue collection, border protection, providing core ICT services across the public sector, government payments, preparing and managing the Annual Budget and advising the government on a range of financial policies and economic reforms.

The Economic Reform Division assists the Ministry of Finance and Treasury by supporting sustainable economic development through economic policy advice, developing and implementing economic reforms.

The unit focusses on three main areas: Macroeconomic analysis and advice; revenue policy analysis and advice; and analysis and advice on business regulation and financial inclusion, including the regulation of State Owned Enterprises (SOE).

This position will support and provide regular advice to the Minister of Finance on macroeconomic issues in particular Real GDP Forecasting, revenue analysis, and inflation forecasting. Supporting the Minister of Finance and Treasury in discharging his responsibilities under the Public Financial Management Act, including providing of economic analysis of on Key government development projects.

- 7. Undertake any other duties as reasonably required or directed by the Responsible Officer or Supervisor.
