PORTS ACT (Cap. 161)

THE LEVY OF RATES AND DUES

(PORTS OF HONIARA AND NORO) RULES 2010

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Ports Act and with the approval of the Minister, the Authority hereby makes the following Rules:-

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Levy of Rates and Dues (Ports of Honiara and Noro) Rules 2010 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
- 2. The rates and dues set out on the Schedules shall be levied by or paid to the Authority in respect of the various matters specified in it, when the work or appliances so specified are provided or the services so specified are provided at the Ports of Honiara and Noro.
- 3. Not withstanding anything in these Rules it shall be lawful for the Authority to enter into any special agreement in respect of any matter in accordance with the charges specified on the Schedules of Rates and Dues hereto.
- 4. The levy of Rates and Dues (Ports of Honiara and Noro) Rules 2006 (Legal Notice 154 of 2007) hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE OF DUES AND RATES PORTS OF HONIARA AND NORO

A currently adjustment factor linked to the Central Bank's "basket" of currencies is applied to all charges levied on overseas vessels under PARTS I AND II of the schedule. The factor applied is advised by public notice from time to time.

PART 1

SHIPS DUES (pursuant to section 57)

The Master of the vessel shall be liable to pay the following ships dues

All the above charges include the provision of mooring launches and lines.

2. Delay Fees:

i. Any vessel arriving more than sixty minutes after the notified time of arrival shall be charged for the time spent waiting for the vessel's arrival.

ii. Any vessel detaining a pilot more than sixty minutes beyond its notified time of departure or removal shall be charged for the whole period of the pilots detention.

3. Port Dues

For the first entry into the Port of Honiara and S8.00 per metre of overall length Noro during each quarter and for the purposes of vessel of this charge quarters shall commence on 1st January, 1st April, 1st July and 1st October.

4. Berthage

All charges levied under this Part shall be payable by vessel licensed in the Solomon Islands and principally employed in voyages involving calling at port in the Solomon Islands.

Levies shall be calculated in accordance with the weights and measurements appearing in ship's manifest (or amendments thereof) on hundred weights to the nearest hundred weights to the nearest hundred weight or cubic feet or metric tonnes to the nearest wentieth. Whichever produces the greater charge on the basis that one-ton shall be forty cubic feet.

First half hour free then thereafter all personnel at \$15.00 per hour or part thereof per person and equipment at hourly hire rates for each hour or part thereof.

b) In the case of the working of a vessel being delayed for any personnel and equipment made ready by the Authority to work the vessel at the time notified to work by the Authority until redeployed or work commences.

As above except the first half hour shall also be charged.

9. Pollution Cleaning Costs shall be charged for any materials, labour and equipment used in containing and cleaning up any occurring in any waters or on any land under the jurisdiction of the Authority.
