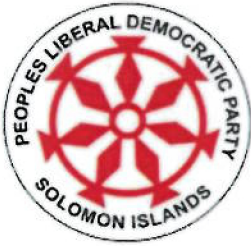

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Objection to the application may be made on the ground that:

- the application is not in accordance with the Act
- the information set out in the application, or any document accompanying the application is incorrect
- the proposed name –
 - (i) is likely to be confused with the name of a political party already registered;
 - (ii) is obscene or offensive;
 - (iii) Includes words the publication of which would likely amount to an offence;
 - (iv) Includes the word "independent"; or
 - (v) Includes any prescribed prohibited matter;
- the proposed symbol –
 - (i) is likely to be confused with the symbol of a political party already registered;
 - (ii) is obscene or offensive;
 - (iii) is of such a character that its publication would likely amount to an offence; or
 - (iv) includes any prescribed symbol, word, phrase or matter that is prohibited.

If you wish to object to the application on any of these grounds, you may submit to the Registrar, by **Friday 18th August 2023** a statement setting out the grounds of objection. The statement should be on Form PPI 5 (obtainable from the Registrar) and must include your name, address and signature.
