

LOADSHEDDING NOTICE HONIARA- Update 104

Date issued: Sunday 15th October 2023

Dear Valued Customers,

Our current generation capacity has now increased to around 17MW from 11MW due to the return of two generators to operation as planned. We anticipate that this will be sufficient to meet power demand within Honiara city for the next few weeks. Maintenance works are still ongoing to further increase generation capacity ensuring added reliability of power supply to Honiara city. Should there be an unexpected increase in the total power demand to more than 17MW or faults with operational generators, the following loadshedding schedule will apply:

8am to 10am:

10am to 12pm:

Feeder 3: King Solomon Hotel, Mud Alley Street, Solomon Telekom, West end of Mendana Avenue, Australian High Commission, BSP Main Branch (Point Cruz), Heritage Park Hotel, Immigration, Ministry of Finance, Prime Minister's Office, British High Commission, SolPlaza, SMI, New Zealand High Com, Coral Sea Resort, Chinese Embassy, IBS, YWCA, SIBC, St. John School, Rove Prison Service, Rove Police Headquarter, Rove Outback Shops, Rove Bulk shop and Surrounding areas.
