**MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT (ENTITLEMENTS) COMMISSION
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2024**

The Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission, under section 69B of the *Constitution*, make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission (Amendment) Regulations 2024*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 January 2024.

3 Amendment of Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission Regulations 1988

These Regulations amend the *Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission Regulations 1988* (“**Principal Regulations**”).

4 Appendix A amended

The Principal Regulations is amended at Appendix A, at **1. Basic Salary**, by repealing the current basic salary figures in each respective class (a) to (e) and substituting them with new basic salary figures as follows:

“(a) Prime Minister	\$428,560.12
“(b) Deputy Prime Minister	\$385,226.79
“(c) Ministers, Leader of Opposition,	

Leader of Independent Group	\$334,539.33
(d) Deputy Speaker, Chairperson of the Parliamentary Caucus, Chairperson of Parliamentary Standing Committees	\$301,894.02
(e) Members	\$272,047.34”.
