PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT

(Cap. 151)

NATIONAL AND SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2024

(a) Under section 2 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Cap. 151) the public is informed that the following days are national public holidays in 2024:

New Year's Day	1 January
Good Friday	29 March
Holy Saturday	30 March
Easter Monday	1 April
Whit Monday	20 May
King's Birthday	15 June (14 June to be observed as a public holiday)
Independence Day	7 July (8 July to be observed as a public holiday)
Christmas Day	25 December
National Day of Thanksgiving	26 December

(b) Under section 6 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Cap. 151), I, Hon. Christopher Laore, Minister for Home Affairs, appoint the following days (Column 2) as Provincial Public Holidays for the following parts of Solomon Islands (Column 1).

Column 1	Column 2
Part of Solomon Islands	Day in 2024 to be kept as a holiday
Central Province	29 June (28 June to be observed as a public holiday)
Choiseul Province	25 February (26 February to be observed as a public holiday)
Guadalcanal Province	1 August
Isabel Province	2 June (3 June to be observed as a public holiday)
Makira, Ulawa Province	3 August (2 August to be observed as a public holiday)
Malaita Province	15 August
Rennell and Bellona Province	20 July (19 July to be observed as a public holiday)
Temotu Province	8 June (7 June to be observed as a public holiday)
Western Province	7 December (6 December to be observed as a public holiday)
