During the construction period access to the craft market shops, hair saloons and cafes will still be maintained but with restricted movement due to the presence of heavy machineries and equipment. For the safety and convenience of everyone, all visitors and customers are advised to follow pedestrian access pathways and corridors that will be set up around the construction site. Vehicle access and movement will be restricted and customers are advised to park along the main road side.
