**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS
OF SERVICE) ACT
(Cap. 84)**

**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF
SERVICE) ATTORNEY GENERAL)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2024**

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under section 3 of the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act* (Cap. 84), make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Attorney General) (Amendment) Regulations 2024*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date these Regulations are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Attorney General) Regulations 2010*

These Regulations amend the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Attorney General) Regulations 2010* (LN No. 103 of 2010) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Regulation 10 repealed and substituted

Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted with the following

“Vehicle

- 10 The Government must provide the following to the Attorney General:
- (a) one government vehicle free of charge and a fuel allowance each month at the rate set out in the Schedule; and
 - (b) a transport allowance each fortnight at the rate set out in the Schedule, if the Government is unable to provide a vehicle; and
 - (c) the vehicle under paragraph (a) may be purchased by the Attorney General at a fair market price, if the Attorney General’s contract has ended and is not renewed.”.

5 Regulation 13 amended

Regulations 13 of the Principal Regulations is amended by substituting “two return trips” with “one return trip”.

6 Regulation 16 repealed and substituted

Regulations 16 of the Principal Regulations is repealing and substituting by following:

“Class of travel (overseas)

- 16 (1) The Attorney General is entitled to travel business class for all official overseas travels.
- (2) The spouse of the Attorney General is entitled to travel business class:
- (a) when accompanying the Attorney General for official overseas travel; and
 - (b) when the spouse is officially required to perform an official role in the Attorney General’s official overseas program of travel; and
 - (c) where subregulations (2)(a) and (b) are met, the spouse is also entitled to claim subsistence allowance at half the rate payable to the Attorney General in regulation 14(1) and 14(2).
- (3) Where subregulations (2)(a) and (b) are not met, the Attorney General and the spouse are responsible for the spouse’s travels.”.

7 Regulation 19 repealed and substituted

Regulation 19 of the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted with

the following:

“Medical treatment

19 If the Attorney General is not covered by medical insurance, the Attorney General is entitled to a medical allowance each year, at the rate set out in the Schedule for outpatient and general practice treatments; and where hospitalisation is required, the Attorney General is entitled to be covered under a Government approved Health Care Scheme.”.

8 Regulation 20 repealed and substituted

The Principal Regulations is amended by repealing regulation 20 and substituting with a new regulation 20 as follows:

“Gratuity

20 The Attorney General is entitled to a gratuity of 35% of the basic salary under regulation 4, payable at the end of every 12 months of service, or at the end of the term.”.

9 Repeal

The *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Attorney General) Regulations 2006* (Legal Notice No. 3 of 2006) is repealed.

Schedule repealed and substituted

The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted with the following:
