

Brief General Instructions

Based on the guidelines provided in the General Information (GI), applicants must first be nominated and endorsed by the Solomon Islands Government and subsequently approved by JICA. Following this process, applicants will undergo screening by their selected universities.

Please note that universities may reject an application if the required documents are incomplete or if the proposed research plan does not meet their criteria. Applicants are also responsible for following the application procedures of their chosen universities after the screening.

If an applicant decides to withdraw after officially applying to a university, they must formally notify both the university and the JICA overseas office in their country.

Upcoming Schedule

For Universities with a Pre-Application Matching Process:

- **By the beginning of September 2026:**
 - Nomination of candidate applicants by their respective organizations.
 - Selection of candidate applicants by the responsible organization in each country.
 - Pre-consultation (required by some universities).

University List

Applicants are advised **not** to send the University List to universities during the pre-consultation process. The information contained in the University List is intended solely for applicants and JICA offices and must not be distributed or shared with universities or other third parties.
