ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY TO PRIME MINISTER

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 37 of the Constitution, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I, SIR DAVID TIVA KAPU, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, hereby assign responsibilities for the conduct of the following business of the Government specified below to the Prime Minister, effective from the date of his taking of oaths before me.
